- provides support to districts/schools in the identification of accessible instructional and assessment media
- supports the use of technology to help students manage their behavior to be successful in the classroom and community
- provide opportunities to explore equipment, components, and program solutions that may expand learning options for students through the use of new and emerging technologies
- facilitate the identification and use of technologies that present information and training through distance education options such as interactive video, on-line courses, and other interactive multimedia methods
